(2 verses)

Lord have Mercy/Glory to God: Good Shepherd Mass (CBW 338a
and b)

Psalm Response: " Our blessing cup is a communion with the blood
of Christ" (Cantor: David)

Gospel Acclamation: "Glory and praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ!"
(Cantor: Brigid)

During Washing of Feet: "As I have done for you" (JS 403) – refrain
with harmony

Offertory Hymn: "Shepherd of Souls" (JS 825)

Gospel Acclamation: “**Glory and praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ!**”

Acclamation during Passion reading:
“**Kyrie, Christe, Kyrie eleison**”

General Intercession:

Priest: “We Pray to the Lord”

Choir/congregation: “**For the sake of your Son, have mercy Lord**”

Hymn during Collection: **silent**

Unveiling of cross:

Priest: This is the wood of the world”

Choir: “**Come, let us worship**” (3 times)

Hymns during Adoration of the Cross:

“**Lord We Adore You**” (refrain 3 X’s – Harmony)

“**Were you there?**” (CBW 493) (vs 1 – unison, 2 & 3 in harmony)

“**By Your Cross**” (Choir sings refrain 8X’s – 1 – unison, 2 – harmony, 3 to 6 – softly in Harmony w/ Erika singing verses, 7 – regular volume in harmony, 8 – softer ‘a capela’)

“**Behold the Wood**” (CBW 489) (Unison – 3 verses)

“**Alas and Did my Savior Bleed**”

Procession with Easter Candle:

Priest: Christ our light”

Choir/Congregation: **“Thanks be to God”** (3 times)

Easter Proclamation:

Priest: “.....reigns for ever and ever”

Choir **“Amen”** (Dresden version)

Psalm #1 **“Lord, Send out your Spirit and renew the face of the earth”**
(booklet P. 68) Cantor: Rosemary

Psalm #3 **“Let us sing to the lord; he has covered himself in glory”**
(booklet P. 77) Cantor: David

Psalm #5 **“You will draw water joyfully from the springs of
salvation”** (booklet P. 83) Cantor: Anthea

Psalm #7 **“Like a deer that longs for running streams, my soul longs
for you, my God”** (booklet P. 89) Cantor: Erika

Gloria: Easter Carol Mass in English (C.T. Andrews)

Solemn Alleluia/Gospel Acclamation: Repeat **“Alleluia”** after Cantor,
and after each verse (Cantor David)

Baptismal rite: Litany of Saints, **“Springs of water, bless the lord...”**
(sing twice) (booklet P. 100)

Sprinkling with Baptismal Water **“O Lord of Life”**

Offertory Hymn: **“ Love Is Come Again”** (JS # 443/CBW 502)

Sanctus/Benedictus: Easter Carol Mass in English (C. T. Andrews)

Acclamation of faith: **Christ has died ...**

Choral Amen: **“ AMEN”** (Tallis Version)

Lord’s Prayer (sing?)

Agnus Dei: Easter Carol Mass in English (C.T. Andrews)

Communion Hymn: **“Just as I am”** (vrs. 2 & 4 – quartet- Margaret, Rosemary,
all tenor and all bass;) interlude between vrs. 3 & 4 – Flute played by Anthea

Final Blessing /dismissal **“ Thanks be to God, Alleluia, Alleluia”**

Closing Hymn: **“Jesus Christ is risen ((JS#425/CBW 500)**
(Verses 1, then Verse 4 with descant and trumpet)

Choir Recessional **“ Thine is the glory”**

(Verse 1 English, verse 1 French, last verse English – women and men
alternate in unison – chorus sung in parts)

EASTER SUNDAY-9:00 AM

Prelude: “The heavens declare God’s mighty power”

Entrance Hymn: “Alleluia!Alleluia!” (JS# 437) (*verse 1, then verse 4 with descant and trumpet*)

Kyrie/Gloria: Easter Carol Mass in English (C.T. Andrews)

Psalm response “This is the day the lord has made, Let us rejoice and be glad” Cantor: David

Sequence: “Alleluia” after each verse by choir – 3x at end (*Verses in order- David, Evelyn, Greg, Monica, Joe, Margaret, and all on last verse*) – Alleluia 3X at end, with harmony (ad lib) on last (**booklet P. 117**)

Gospel Acclamation: Repeat “Alleluia” after Cantor (*David*) at beginning and end

During sprinkling with Baptismal Water “ O Lord of Life”

Offertory Hymn: “ Love Is Come Again”(JS#443/CBW 502)

Sanctus/Benedictus: Easter Carol Mass in English (C.T. Andrews)

Acclamation of faith: Christ has died ...

Three-fold Amen: “ AMEN” (**Danish Amen**)

Lord’s Prayer (? sing?)

Agnus Dei: Easter Carol Mass in English (C.T. Andrews)

Communion Hymn: “Just as I am” (vrs. 2 & 4 – quartet- Margaret, Trish, all tenor and all bass;) interlude between vrs. 3 & 4 – Flute played by Anthea

Solemn Blessing /dismissal “ Thanks be to God, Alleluia”

Closing Hymn: “Jesus Christ is risen (JS#425/CBW 500) (*verse 1, then verse 4 with descant and trumpet*)

Choir Recessional: “ Thine is the glory” (Verse 1 English, verse 1 French. last verse English – women and men alternate in unison – chorus sung in parts)
